

**RED SPRINGS BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING  
BUDGET MEETING  
TUESDAY, April 24, 2017  
8:00 AM**

**The Red Springs Board of Commissioners met in the Town Hall Planning Board Room for a FY2017/2018 Budget meeting on Monday, April 24, 2017 at 6:00 PM.**

The meeting was opened by the Mayor. He explained changes that were made to the budget since the last budget meeting. He stated that he wants to remove the \$80,000 Electric Dept. Services Rendered to the General Fund.

Discussion/Comments

- There was much discussion regarding the anticipated FEMA revenue for the current as well as the next fiscal year.
- The town has been notified of an inheritance of \$30,000 from a resident. The Mayor suggested that the funds go into the General Fund Capital Reserve account. All board members agreed.
- The Mayor questioned the entry of \$17,000 in the Water/Sewer Insurance Proceeds Revenues for \$17,000. The Town Manager explained that this is the amount expected for damage to the Water Treatment Facility during Hurricane Matthew.
- The Town Manager explained the low amount shown in the Water/Sewer Revenues for Robeson County Water Sales. The Mayor stated that there should be a written agreement between the town and the county regarding this issue. He reminded everyone that at this point in time the county is using town water, but with the condition of the Town's Water Treatment Plant, the town could be in need of receiving water from the county at a future date. Also, he said this topic should be added to the Town of Red Springs Code of Ordinances.
- Mayor McNeill noted that the July, 2017 regular board meeting will occur on July 4, 2017. He directed the Town Manager to present 2 alternative dates to the Board of Commissioners at the May 2, 2017 regular meeting.

Adjournment

Commissioner McKeithan made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner McNeill seconded the motion. All voted to approved the motion.
